



Arrowhead Scarf



GAUGE

4 inches = 15 sts in Stockinette stitch using Size 10 (6mm) needles

MATERIALS

Size 10 (6mm) circular needle – 24" (Or size necessary to obtain correct gauge).

250-270 yds of Cascade Eco wool (or any chunky yarn)

2 Stitch markers

Crochet Hook (any size) to attach fringe

Darning needle to sew ends in

ABBREVIATIONS

CO – Cast-on

K – Knit

P- Purl

St – Stitch

pm – place a stitch marker

Sl m – slip the stitch marker to the other needle

Inc – increase

YO – yarn over

M1 – make one (see tutorial below)

Rem - remain

BO – Bind off

MEASUREMENTS

35" wide x 17" deep (excluding fringe)



INSTRUCTIONS

CO 5 sts

Knit in garter stitch (all knit) for 2 rows.

Next row: K2, pm, K1, pm, K2

These 3 rows form your foundation. The next row begins the pattern of increasing every other row.

Row 1 (and every odd row): K1, YO, K to st m, M1, sl m, K1, sl m, M1, K until 1 st rem, YO, K1.

Row 2 (and every even row): K2, P across row (slipping the stitch markers when you come to them) until 2 sts rem, K2

Repeat these 2 rows until 12 inches have been worked (by measuring the depth along the centre increase line)

Still alternating increase rows and even rows, K in garter stitch for 1.5".

BO and weave in ends to finish.

OPTIONAL FRINGE

Cut 5" (or as long as desired) lengths of yarn. Fold each in half and knot through each edge stitch along the 'V' edge.



M1 Tutorial



Ladder rung between last st knit and next st to be knit.



Pick up and knit into the back of the stitch to make 1.
